

Boys and Girls Junior Sections 2008-09

This year sees the start of the Single System in hockey with guidelines laid down for both boys and girls by England Hockey. Similar systems are being adopted by other major sports.

It will be a time a change and transition whilst we pilot our new programmes but, we hope, that we will all benefit from the new structure. We welcome any feedback and ideas that teachers, coaches, players and parents may have, as the programmes will need to evolve and change over the forthcoming years.

The most obvious change is that County Trials for each age group will be replaced by a series of Junior Development Centres (JDC) which will take place in the North, Middle and South of the County to make access easier. These JDC's will then play each other and from this players will invited to attend Junior Academy Centres (JAC) for coaching and competitions with JAC's from other counties. This will replace the old County system.

Those players not progressing to JACs will be encouraged to continue with school hockey and be provided with information on local club activity, until the Junior Development Centres resume next year. Players can attend any JDC, so can choose to attend the one that is most convenient for them and their families.

Progression from the Junior Academy Centres will be by invitation to Regional Performance Centres, two of which will replace the old Midlands Performance Centres.

All Centres will be run by qualified coaches and the aim is that by 2009-10 season there will be a co-ordinated programme delivered throughout the Country.

Schools tournaments will still continue and further information on these is available in the booklet.

Travelling along A6 from Derby turn right at traffic lights in Cromford up the hill. Pass under the High Peak Trail bridge, down the hill into Wirksworth. Pass through the town, turning left just before mini-roundabout onto Water Lane. Hannage Way is first left.

Belper Hockey Club

From Derby travelling on A6 pass through Belper until you reach traffic lights at triangular junction for A517 to Ashbourne. Take left turn 10 meters before traffic lights, passing into narrow lane signposted to Belper Town Football Club. The Astroturf is beyond the football pitch.

Repton School

Take A38 TOWARDS Birmingham. At B5008 Willington/Repton turn left. Continue through Willington to Repton. On approaching the village turn right at the 30mph sign, into the school grounds.

Tupton Hall School

From the North take the A61 from Chesterfield heading towards Clay Cross. At the second roundabout (Royal Oak pub on the corner) turn left and follow road around sharp left hand bend. Take first right into Station New Road. School is 600m on the right.
From the South take A61 FROM Alfreton towards Clay Cross. At first roundabout past Clay Cross(Royal Oak pub on corner) turn right and follow directions above.
